## Directions for Registering for an ICCT Summer Course

Before completing your registration form, please read the information on our Web site about the courses, children's programs, on-campus facilities and costs. You can also call or e-mail us to ask for a brochure.

- To register, complete either the [SLA Registration Form](#) or [TESOL Registration Form](#) and return it to ICCT. Couples should use two separate forms. (To fill out the PDF form on your computer, rather than by hand, you may need to use Acrobat Reader 8 rather than an earlier version. When you click on one of the registration forms, it may take a little longer than usual for the form to load.)

You may choose one of the following eleven course combinations. (Refer to the course descriptions for more information about each course.) If you wish, you may combine credit and non-credit courses

- For early registration (on or before April 1), return your completed registration form and a non-refundable deposit of \$50. (Make the check out to ICCT.) After April 1, you may enroll by returning the form with a non-refundable fee of \$75, with \$50 serving as a deposit. (Current Wheaton College students, faculty/staff and their family members who are entitled to the educational benefit should submit the registration form but do not need to include a deposit.)
- If you are not currently enrolled as a student at Wheaton College and you want to earn credit for one or more ICCT courses (maximum, six hours of credit), you must complete a Wheaton College Special Student Summer Application for Admission. This will allow you to receive graduate credit which can be used toward a Wheaton degree or transferred to another institution. Click [here](#) for the form. (It is also on the Graduate Admissions Web site.) For the least expensive tuition rates, this special student form should be returned to Graduate Admissions allowing ample time for them to process your application and complete your course registration before the early registration cut-off date in mid-April. (We suggest that you send in your Special Student form no later than March 1.)
- Upon receipt of your completed registration form and deposit, we will send you a confirmation e-mail, a statement of amount due, information about travel to Wheaton, and an information sheet that includes a list of items to bring with you.
- On-campus registration will be from 2 - 9:30 p.m. on the day before the ICCT summer program begins. If you are living on campus, you may move into your apartment at that time.
