In 1965, because of the growing interest in these seven British authors, Dr. Clyde S. Kilby of Wheaton College conceived the idea of starting a collection. Beginning with a small number of books and letters by C.S. Lewis, the Marion E. Wade Center now holds thousands of manuscripts, letters, first editions and other primary materials.

In 1980, Dr. Barbara Reynolds, Dr. Clyde S. Kilby and Dr. Beatrice Batson founded *SEVEN: An Anglo-American Literary Review*. Born out of the need and opportunity for discussion and balanced assessment of these seven British authors, *SEVEN* is intended for both the general and specialized reader.
