<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> Wheaton in Chicago (WIC) program may be taken in almost any fall or spring semester. The usual sequence suggests that students take URBN 114 prior to WIC, and the URBN 494 (2 credits) the next spring semester following WIC, although exceptions can be made to this ordering of courses according to student need. URBN 399 (0 credits) is always taken the semester prior to WIC.
