²Majors must take IR 155 and IR 175 and *either* PSCI 135 or PSCI 145. All four are offered every semester.

³A total of 16 hours of electives are required. All must be at the 300-level or higher. 4 hours may be from PSCI courses.

⁴Majors must take 12 hours of supporting courses. Completion of 4 hours of Foreign Language learning *beyond competency* is a requirement.
