

Transfer Guide College of DuPage to Wheaton College

This document is intended to help students who wish to begin at the College of DuPage plan for courses that will later transfer to Wheaton College and meet Wheaton requirements. It is not exhaustive and is subject to change. Current students MUST have preapproval for all courses taken outside of Wheaton.

Core Competencies:

Writing - ENGLI 1101 and 1102 are both required to fully meet Wheaton's writing competency.

Oral Skills - SPEEC 1100 or 2160 (must be taken in person, not online)

Foreign Language - Wheaton College requires completion through the intermediate level (through Intermediate II or through level 4 in sign language) to meet competency. Foreign language classes must be taken in person, not online.

Thematic Core

A maximum of four themes can be met with transfer credit. Courses on the list beyond four themes would come in as elective credits. Transfer students with 60+ credits may bring in six themes.

AAQR (Math) - MATH 2231 if calculus is needed for your intended major. Otherwise MATH 1432, MATH 1533, or MATH 1635 will meet the AAQR requirement.

Historical Perspectives - HISTO 1110

Literary Explorations - ENGLI 1130

Philosophical Investigations - PHILO 1100

Scientific Issues & Perspectives – EARTH 1111, EARTH 1124

Scientific Practice (Lab Sciences) - BIOLO 1100, EARTH 1102, PHYSI 1201, or PHYSI 2111.

If majoring in Biology, Chemistry or Applied Health Science, take BIOLO 1151 & 1152 and CHEMI 1551 & 1552. We do not recommend taking Anatomy & Physiology courses because they will not meet the requirement for the major at Wheaton. Engineering & Physics majors should begin with PHYSI 2111. Must be taken with an in person weekly lab.

Social Inquiry - ANTHR 1100, ECONO 2202, POLS 1101, PSYCH 1100, or SOCIO 1100

Visual & Performing Arts - ART 1100 and MUSIC 1100 (need both to complete the theme)

Major Courses

Round out your schedule with entry level courses in a major you are interested in pursuing. Wheaton College requires a certain number of courses in the major be taken at Wheaton, so it is best not to take a large number of major courses.

* We do not transfer associate degrees. Transfer credits are awarded course by course.
