Bass Trombone

ALL

 All students must prepare two contrasting movements of a solo (no piano accompaniment) or two contrasting etudes.

---AND---

ORCHESTRA AND BAND

- In addition to the self-selected solo movements/etudes, students who wish to be considered for placement in Symphonic Band <u>and</u> Symphony Orchestra, or just Symphony Orchestra, must prepare all five excerpts in this PDF:
 - o Wagner Scene 2 from *Das Rheingold*
 - Haydn No. 26 from *The Creation*
 - o Berlioz Hungarian March from The Damnation of Faust
 - Wagner Ride of the Walküre from Das Walküre
 - o Holst First Suite for Military Band

---OR----

BAND ONLY

- In addition to the self-selected solo movements/etudes, students who wish to be considered for placement in Symphonic Band <u>only</u> must prepare the last three excerpts in this PDF, marked with an asterisk (*):
 - Wagner *Ride of the Walküre* from *Das Walküre*
 - o Holst First Suite for Military Band

Richard Wagner: Das Rheingold, Scene 2

Trombone IV: Play excerpt as marked

Most recent tempo indication: *Moderato* [appears at the beginning of the Scene] Tempo indication in the original, German edition: *Ruhiges Zeitmass*



Josef Haydn: The Creation (Die Schöpfung), Part II, No. 26

Trombone III: No. 26. Start at the beginning; stop at letter C (First 37 measures)



Hector Berlioz: Hungarian March from The Damnation of Faust

Trombone 3: 6 measures before Rehearsal No. 4 through 2nd measure of Rehearsal No. 5 Meter: cut time (2/2)

Most recent tempo indication: *Allegro marcato (half note = 88)* [appears at the beginning of the piece]





Richard Wagner: Ride of the Walküre from Die Walküre

Trombone IV: Second B-major section: pickup to Rehearsal # 11 through the downbeat of 5 measures after Rehearsal #12

Tempo indication in the original, German edition: Lebhaft





Gustav Holst: First Suite in E-flat for Military Band

Trombone III: Movement 1, Chaconne.

Two excerpts as marked (both are approximately quarter note = 100):

Measure 8 to nine measures before Rehearsal A

8 measures after Rehearsal A to the downbeat of Rehearsal C
