

All education majors are encouraged to complete one or more endorsement(s) to add to the initial elementary or secondary/high school or special K-12 Professional Educator License (PEL), building on a strong liberal arts foundation and enhancing employment opportunities.

These subsequent endorsements each require 18 hours of coursework, and in almost all cases, (with the exception of ESL), require passing a state discipline-specific content test. Appropriate discipline-specific general education requirements can be counted toward these hours. Some, like all middle grade endorsements, require a specific methods course as part of the 18 hours.
