1.	Arrive 10 minutes early so you are ready to go when your observation starts.  Act professionally and in accordance with Wheaton College standards.  Dress in business professional attire unless otherwise instructed – no jeans, leggings, sweatpants, t shirts or sweatshirts. Please remember that this is a professional organization and that typically, the dress code is business attire.  Treat all staff, patients and caregivers with respect and dignity regardless of age, gender, race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, disability, or sexual orientation.  Adhere to HIPAA and organization confidentiality and privacy requirements.  Unless you have a break or are on lunch, phones are to be put away.  Respect the role of "observer" by not engaging in any direct patient care.  Report concerns about patient safety to attending physician or leadership.  Protect the well being of patients and staff by not shadowing if you are feeling ill or have had a fever and/or vomiting within 24 hours of your scheduled visit. Contact the Health Professions office AND shadowing site to report absence due to illness.
