Second Language Acquisition (SLA)

Each course includes personalized, flexible instruction in phonetics (pronunciation), foundations (framework for language learning), and language learning techniques (guided practice with a language helper). All learners receive unlimited free language learning support.

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| SLA for Beginning Learners | Pre-field or new-to-field learners planning to minister in heart language for 3+ years | 6 weeks, 15-20 hours/week 12 weeks, 7-10 hours/week; ~100 hours total. \$1250 |
| SLA for Continuing Learners | Intermediate/advanced learners looking to advance in language proficiency | 6 weeks, 15-20 hours/week 12 weeks, 7-10 hours/week; ~100 hours total. \$1250 |
| Introduction to Language Learning | Pre-field or new-to-field learners planning to minister in English but needing language for daily life. | 3 weeks, 15-20 hours/week; 6 weeks, 7-10 hours/week; ~50 hours total. \$800 |
| Jump-Start SLA | Pre-field or new-to-field learners with little time for language study or preparation. | 1 week, 20 hours/week; 4 weeks, 5 hours/week; 20 hours total. \$300 |
| Language Coaching Add-on | One year of on-field individual and group coaching calls. Add on to any course. | 1-3 hours per month. \$400 |

Cross-Cultural Living & Ministry

For new and seasoned workers, this course provides a framework, tools, and activities to learn the host culture's patterns and values through videos, readings, and weekly video calls with an instructor. \$500 (\$100 discount if taken with SLA course). 11 weeks, 2-3 hours/week OR 4-5 weeks, 6-8 hours/week.

All courses are offered online and taught by instructors with M.A. degrees or higher in related fields and significant cross-cultural experience.

English Teacher Training

We offer 8 and 10-hour workshops and 30-hour courses in English as a second language (ESL) teaching for those working with English learners around the world. Discounts available for course alumni, multiple courses, early registration, and Wheaton College students.

| Reach Out With English (ROWE) - 30 hours (one week) | Provides a strong foundation in ESL / EFL teaching and includes topics such as needs analysis, lesson planning, ESL methodology, materials selection, and more. | \$375-\$425 |

| Basics of Teaching ESL 101, 102, 103; Essentials of Teaching Vocabulary 401; Essentials of One-to-One ESL Teaching 402 - 8 hours each | Provide practical instruction on foundational topics for English teachers and volunteers. Basics 101, 102, and 103 can be combined (with 6 hours of additional work) for the 30-hour ROWE certificate. | \$95-\$115 |
