Foundational Courses: 8 hours

- ENGL 215 Classical and Early British Literature (4)
- ENGL 226 Topical Seminar (4) Pre-requisite Lit 215, open to other majors as space allows.
(Teaching Concentration students must sign up for this Shakespeare-related seminar. If Teaching Concentration is declared after student has already taken the Topical Seminar, then the student must take the Shakespeare Figure Course (ENGL 384) to meet this requirement.

Historical Framework: 16 hours

- 8 hrs in British or world literature post-1800 (350-370 range)
 - ENGL 355 Romantic (recommended)
 - ENGL 361 Victorian (recommended)
 - ENGL 364 British Modernism: 1900-1939
 - ENGL 365 British Literature after 1939

- 8 hrs in American Literature (two different periods)
 - ENGL 341 Beginnings to Romanticism
 - ENGL 342 Realism to Modernism
 - ENGL 343 After 1945

Teaching Concentration: 16 Hours

- Topical courses required for certification
 - ENGL 328 Young Adult Literature (4)

- Recommended:
 - ENGL 375 Women Writers
 - ENGL 379 African American
