

Guidelines for Transfer Courses for Legacy Students (entered prior to Fall 2016)

For students who entered Wheaton prior to Fall 2016, the following guide will govern transfer approval for courses taken outside of Wheaton to meet general education requirements.

Requirement	Courses that can be transferred for this requirement
Core Competecies	
First-year Writing	At most Community Colleges this will be Composition 1 AND Composition 2. For students who need only ENGW 104, it must be a writing course that has a significant research project and covers library research skills.
Oral Communicatoin	Public Speaking is the only course that meets this requirement. It must be taken in person; not online.
Foreign Language	Students should anticipate taking their intermediate language course at Wheaton. Elementary FL courses may be taken elsewhere, but students are cautioned that due to textbook differences, community college courses may not fully prepare them for 201 at Wheaton. FL courses must be taken in person; online courses are not allowable.
Wellness	To be taken at Wheaton.
Quantitative Skills	Statistics, Applied Calculus, Calculus I (note Finite Math and College Algebra can only be taken at Wheaton).

Faith and Reason Cluster	
Gospel, Church & Culture	No longer offered.
Old Testament	Must be from a Christian College
New Testament	Must be from a Christian College
Christian Thought	By syllabus review only
Philosophy	Introduction to Philosophy

Studies in Society Cluster	
History	World History 1600-present from vetted list, or by syllabus review by History Dept.
Social Science	Intro to Anthropology, Principles of Microeconomics, American Politics & Government, Intro to Political Philosophy, Comparative Politics, International Relations, Introduction to Sociology

Studies in Diversity	Intro to Anthropology, Intro to Sociology, History course that comes in as HIST 105, Global Literature, Global Music Survey, or by review
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Literature and Arts Cluster	
Literature	Many Literature courses, excluding Children's & Adolescent Literature
Art	Art Appreciation (transfer studio art courses are not able to meet requirement)
Music	Music Appreciation or Global Music Survey (transfer lessons, theory, ensembles and methods courses are not able to meet requirement)
Theatre	Not able to be met by transfer credit.

A Transfer Approval Form must be submitted to the Registrar's Office for pre-approval for any course to be taken at another school. Courses in one's major, minor or certificate must have department approval on the form.
