## TUITION AND FEE PAYMENT

All Fall 2026 semester charges are to be paid by Wednesday, August 26, 2026. If a balance remains after August 26, a \$75.00 late payment will be charged. In addition, a 1.5% per month late charge on the average balance will be assessed to all unpaid student accounts unless on the Wheaton Installment Program.

## COURSE ADDS & DROPS

Students desiring to add and/or drop courses must do so on Banner: Student Services by the appropriate deadlines (see above). A drop in total hours which impacts tuition charges will result in a full refund through September 8, 2026, with no refund thereafter.

## WITHDRAWAL FROM COLLEGE

Any student finding it necessary to withdraw from the College while currently enrolled in class must complete and submit the Withdraw or Cancel Enrollment form and meet with the Dean of Student Wellness in the Student Development office. **A student who does not officially withdraw with the required approvals receives no refund.** Consult the College Catalog for withdrawal refund policies.

## U.S. VOTER REGISTRATION

The Higher Education Act of 1998 requires colleges and universities to make a good faith effort to make voter registration forms available to you. A limited number of voter registration forms for the State of Illinois are available to students at Wheaton College during business hours on campus. ## INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADVANCE REGISTRATION FOR FALL 2026

The preferred method of registration is via Banner: Student Services. **You may initiate web registration at the time posted in your Banner: Student Service accounts (see web registration instructions below).**

All degree-seeking graduate and undergraduate students who plan to continue in the fall at Wheaton College should initiate advance registration by April 10, 2026. **Failure to do so may result in a cancellation of your housing assignment and may require an application for late registration and result in a \$75 late registration fee.**

Students applying for off-campus study for Fall should complete the GoGlobal process and submit their confirmation of course enrollment form to the Global Programs and Studies (GPS) Office by April 10, 2026.

Please complete the following:

1. Make an appointment with your faculty advisor for advising. *First-year and Transfer students* should refer to instructions from the Academic Advising Office.
2. Complete preliminary planning prior to your advisor meeting.
  - a. Check the Catalog ([catalog.wheaton.edu](http://catalog.wheaton.edu)) for course descriptions, pre-requisites, and general requirements.
  - b. Check Degree Works for outstanding requirements. Degree Works is available under the Banner: Student Services menu on the [Wheaton Gateway](#).
3. Have your **faculty advisor** provide you with your **ALTERNATE (Registration) PIN**.

### DIRECTIONS FOR WEB REGISTRATION

1. Login to your [Wheaton Gateway](#) account. Your login/password should be your network username and password. If you have difficulty accessing your account, please contact Academic & Institutional Technology (AIT) at 630.752.4357.
2. Navigate to the Banner: Student Services menu.
3. Select **REGISTRATION DASHBOARD**.
4. Select **ADD AND DROP CLASSES**.
5. Select the **FALL 2026 TERM** and submit.
6. When prompted, input the **ALTERNATE (Registration) PIN** you received from your advisor.
7. Input the CRNs of the courses you wish to register for in the appropriate boxes and submit.
8. If a class is closed, certain classes will allow you to join the waitlist for the class. **Select the waitlist option from the dropdown box and submit.** Please note that for many courses that have a corequisite lab the waitlist for the course is on the lab, not the lecture. The instructor will need to contact the Registrar's Office for any overrides or exceptions for course registration.

### AUDIT POLICY

#### Undergraduate:

With permission of the course instructor, any Wheaton student may audit up to two courses a semester by filing an approved audit application at the Registrar's Office by the second week of the course. A \$50 student rate audit fee is charged per course, plus any course fees. Alumni and non-degree students auditing undergraduate courses are charged the full audit fee rate, plus any course fees. Private lessons, tutorials, internships, practicums, independent studies, and courses taken during study abroad programs cannot be audited. Students may not audit any class for the purpose of preparing for a competency exam.

An audit does not meet any Wheaton degree requirement. Registration for an audit must be completed by the add deadline for the respective course. Students may drop an audited courses only by the deadline to drop without a W for the course.

No credit is given for courses audited, but all audited courses will appear on a student's transcript at the end of the term.

Audits will appear on a student's transcript with an "AU" (audit) if the following requirements are met:

- Attend at least 75% of the class sessions.
- Complete course assignments as determined by the instructor (e.g. reading, class exercises, class discussion). Major papers and final exams are not required. Any feedback provided by the instructor for assignments submitted by the auditor is optional and at the discretion of the instructor.

If the previous requirements are not met the audit will appear on the transcript with a "NA" (Audit not completed). In either case, the audited course grade will not impact a student's GPA or academic progress

## AUDIT POLICY (cont.)

### Graduate School

Any full-time Graduate School student may audit one course without an audit fee by filing an approved audit application at the Registrar's Office. In addition, part-time graduate students who will complete *all* graduation requirements by the end of the current semester are entitled to an audit without an audit fee. Part-time graduate students auditing courses are charged the student audit rate. Non-degree students auditing Graduate School courses are charged the full audit fee rate. In all cases, students are charged published course fees.

An audit does not meet any Wheaton degree requirement. Registration for an audit must be completed by the add deadline for the respective course. Students may drop an audited courses only by the deadline to drop without a W for the course. Tutorials, internships, practicums, independent studies, and courses taken during study abroad programs cannot be audited.

No credit is given for audited courses, but all audited courses will appear on a student's transcript at the end of the term. Audits will appear on a student's transcript with an "AU" (audit) if the following requirements are met:

- Attend at least 75% of the class sessions.
- Complete course assignments as determined by the instructor (e.g. reading, class exercises, class discussion). Major papers and final exams are not required. Any feedback provided by the instructor for assignments submitted by the auditor is optional and at the discretion of the instructor.

If the previous requirements are not met the audit will appear on the transcript with a "NA" (Audit not completed). In either case, the audited course grade will not impact a student's GPA or academic progress.

### **Spouse Audits**

The audit privilege for a full-time graduate student may be used by the student's spouse if the student is not auditing a course. Application for a spouse audit is made through the Registrar's Office. The guidelines above apply to spouse audits.

## Experimental Courses: Fall 2026

### EXPERIMENTAL COURSES (on the schedule, but not in the catalog)

#### **COMM 310. Friendship and Relational Communication. (2cr.) CRN 84900**

This course seeks to better familiarize you with the basic communication processes that occur within the context of a particular kind of relations: close relationships (friendship, romantic relationships, family). This course is designed to increase students' awareness of the processes that govern personal relationships, including the social, emotional, and relational consequences of interpersonal messages. Students will be exposed to scientific theories and research findings in the relational and interpersonal communication literature. Whereas interpersonal communication (COMM 221) encompasses a broader domain of interaction between people, relational communication is focused on the reciprocal process by which communication defines relationships and relationships in turn influence communication. Although there are no "easy answers" when it comes to developing and maintaining good relationships, the knowledge gained from this class will help you better understand yourself and your relationships.

#### **PHP 280. Healthcare in Practice: Policy, Systems, and the Professional Experience in Modern Medicine. (2cr.) CRN 84851**

This course explores how healthcare systems and policies impact healthcare professionals, patients, and society at large. Students will critically examine the structure, organization, cost, and value of the U.S. healthcare system, identifying its strengths and weaknesses. Through policy analysis and case studies students will develop a deeper understanding of the complex forces that influence healthcare delivery and outcomes. Linear Quad.

#### **PSYC 350. Intercultural and Cross-Cultural Psychology. (4cr.) CRN 84901**

The more we learn about human psychology, the more we see that culture deeply impacts all aspects of our experience as embodied people. This course juggles approaching the impact of culture on psychology from a comparative lens (cross-cultural psychology), a relational lens (intracultural psychology), and ultimately, understands the study of psychology itself as being inherently cultural (cultural psychology). Although cross-cultural psychology utilizes research globally, there will be an emphasis on the lived experiences of diverse individuals, cultures, and communities in a U.S. context. Not open to students who have passed PSYC 235.

Prerequisite: PSYC 101
