Christopher Wayne Mitchell of La Habra, California died very unexpectedly of a heart attack July 10, 2014 while he and Julie were visiting their daughter Nisha and her family in

Colorado. He and son-in-law Mike and another friend were fishing in the Rockies at the time. He was born on October 20, 1951 in Portland, Oregon to Jack and Patricia Mitchell. His siblings are Jack (Pep), Tom and Suzan Smith.

Chris was a long time member of the faculty of Wheaton College and of Wheaton Bible Church in Wheaton, Illinois and recently moved to teach in the Torrey Honors Program at Biola University in La Mirada, California. Chris was a noted C.S. Lewis scholar who served as the Director of the Marion E. Wade Center at Wheaton College for 19 years. He had spoken in many places in the US and abroad.

He is survived by his wife, Julie, of 39 years, and his children Nisha Lowe and husband Mike, Joshua, Luke and wife Sarah, and Jeremy. He also has 4 grandchildren, Erick, Jackson, Griffin and Ruby.

Springs of Hope admits boys and girls between the ages of infancy to four years who have been orphaned, abandoned, abused, and neglected. Since Mary Musyoka founded the home, more than 89 children have been referred from local police stations, hospitals, and residents of Machakos.

After nurturing, loving, and protecting the children placed in her care, Mary networks with local officials and families to place each child into a foster or adoptive home. Through the adoptive process, Mary and Springs of Hope work to empower the children and families in the Machakos area and create long-term change in the local community.
